Cutting:

Background (cream Grunge)

Cut 1 strip 1" x WOF (width of fabric)

Subcut into 16: 1" squares

Cut 1 strip 2" x WOF

Subcut into 8: 2" x 4" rectangles

Cut 1 strip 1 3/4" x WOF


Subcut into 8: 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares

Flower Petals (Pink, Lt. Blue, Navy, Orange)
From each color cut 4: 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares
Green Stem


Cut 4: 2" x 2" squares

Piecing the Block:


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1" background squares. With right sides together, place the square on the top right corner of a petal 2 1/4" square. Stitch on the line and trim 1/4" away from the seam. Press seams open and flip up background triangle to fill in the corner. Repeat for remaining petal pieces.




2. Assemble the flower as shown using 1/4" seams. Press seams open. Repeat so you have 4 flowers. Use a single petal color per flower.




3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of background 1 3/4" squares. With right sides together, place background square on the top right corner of green stem 2" square. Stitch on the drawn line and trim to 1/4". Press seams open. Layer another background 1 3/4" square on the bottom left corner and repeat. Make 4 stem units.



4. Using a flower, stem and two 2" x 4" rectangles, assemble the block as shown using a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat for all 4 flowers.





5. Assemble the 4 flower blocks as shown and sew together with a 1/4" seam allowance.



Appliqué the Block:

- 1. Trace 8 leaves and 4 flower centers onto the release paper of the HeatNBond.
- 2. Use an iron, on wool setting, to apply the traced HeatNBond to the wrong side of the green and yellow fabrics and cut out the shapes.
- 3. Remove the release paper from all shapes and determine where to place the pieces on the block.
- 4. Sew around the edges of each piece to secure in place. You may wish to use your favorite decorative stitches.
- 5. Press block flat and enjoy.
