

# Knit Tie Face Mask

1. Cut Fabric: Cut 2 pieces of Quilting Cotton 9" x 7". Note: Please use different fabric for the front and back so people know which side to keep next to their face. Cut 1" wide strip of knit. Stretch it so it curls and cut into 4-16" long pieces. Tie all 4 pieces together at one end.



2. Place Ties: Pin a tie to the top and bottom of the short ends of one rectangle 1/2" from the edge. Pin the ties to the RIGHT side of the fabric. Place the second piece of fabric on top (right sides together) and pin around all the edges.



3. Sew: Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew around the entire facemask leaving a 2 inch opening along the bottom for turning. Backstitch over the ties. Clip corners and turn right side out. If you have a nose piece, slide it into the mask at this point. Stitch the opening closed.



4. Create Tucks. Fold mask into thirds and press. Create 1/2" pintucks facing upwards using pressed marking as a guide.



5. Topstitch: Sew around the outside of the entire mask using a 1/4" seam allowance making sure to tack all the pintucks in place.
